

# Cross-Linked PEEK Proton Exchange Membranes for Fuel Cell

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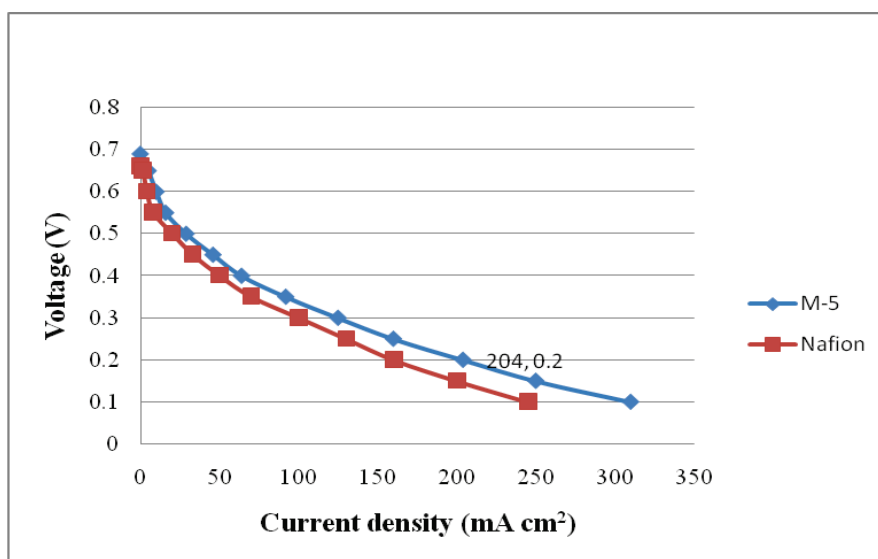
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## Abstract

The low-cost cross-linked Polyetheretherketone (PEEK) proton exchange membranes were prepared via the simple route. The membranes exhibited similar electrochemical properties as compared with commercial Nafion<sup>®</sup>. The membranes were highly proton conductive, mechanically and chemically stable. They showed reduced water uptake and reduced methanol crossover.

The membrane was applied in a direct methanol fuel cell (DMFC) and a considerable performance improvement was found as compared to commercial Nafion<sup>®</sup> 117 membrane. These results suggested that the prepared cross-linked membrane is a suitable candidate for the polymer electrolyte membrane fuel cell (PEMFC) application.
